The Institute for Accounting of the University of Bern aims to bring in visiting faculty conducting research in managerial accounting during the academic year 2024/25.

The aim of the visit is to enable new research collaborations, to foster knowledge exchange, and to explore new or emerging research topics in the field of managerial accounting. The program addresses management accounting faculty at all levels (assistant, associate or full professor) from all over the world whose research is in managerial accounting or a closely related field. It offers visiting professors the opportunity to get to know the Institute for Accounting at the University of Bern. The visit does not involve any teaching requirements.

We offer financial support for a research stay at our institute.

- Who can apply: Faculty members from (inter-)national research organizations and universities at all levels (assistant, associate and full professor).
- Duration: The Institute for Accounting offers funding for a research stay of 1-6 months.
- Funding: You will receive a research grant from the Management Accounting Section of the Institute for Accounting of the University of Bern of CHF 6'000/month for assistant professors, CHF 8'000/month for associate professors and CHF 10'000/month for full professors.
 Additionally, we will reimburse your travel costs to and from Bern.
